## **DIGERATI TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

This Licence constitutes:

A legal agreement between you (either as an individual or a single entity) and Digerati Pty Ltd. ("Digerati"). In this agreement a reference to the Software refers to the Tradewise New Zealand computer software and includes any trial, upgrades, information updates provided by Digerati however delivered, associated media and 'online' or electronic documentation (together 'Program'). By installing, copying, or otherwise using the Software you indicate your acceptance of the terms of this Licence and the fees referred to below. Such acceptance shall bind you and all of your employees, sub contractors and agents to the terms of this Licence. If you do not wish to accept the terms, return this package unopened to Digerati and any Licence fee you may have paid will be refunded to you.

### **LICENCE**

1.1 Pursuant to this Licence, the Licensee acquires a non-exclusive right to: (a) install and use the enclosed software; (b) make one copy for backup purposes only; and (c) use the program strictly in accordance with the provisions of this Licence.

1.2 The Licensee may store or install a copy of the Software on a storage device, such as a network server, for the purposes only of installing or running the Software on the Licensee's computers over an internal network or for the purposes of installing or running the Software on the premises of a sub-contractor or other agent. The Licensee, however, must provide to Digerati details of the number of devices on which the Software is installed or on which the Software is run from a storage device and must pay any Licence fees notified by Digerati which are to be calculated on the basis of the number of devices on which the Software is installed or on which the Software is run from a storage device.

1.3 The Software is licensed as a single product and its component parts must not be separated.

### **DOCUMENTATION**

2.1 This Licence extends to any enclosed or related or downloaded documentation.

### **LICENSEE'S OBLIGATIONS**

3.1 The Licensee hereby undertakes the following obligations: (a) to not copy, reproduce, translate, adapt, vary or modify the Software without the express consent of Digerati, except as authorized by this agreement; (b) to not reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the Software, except and only to the extent that such activity is expressly permitted by applicable law notwithstanding this limitation; (c) to supervise and control the use of the Software in accordance with the terms of this Licence; (d) to ensure its employees, sub-contractors and other agents who have authorised access to the Software are made aware of the terms of this Licence; (e) to not make, provide or otherwise make available the Software in any form to any person other than those referred to in paragraph (d) without the written consent of Digerati; (f) to not sub licence, rent or lease the Software or otherwise dispose of it or create any security interest in it (as defined in the Personal Property Securities Act 1999)

### **UPDATES**

4.1 Updates to the Software will be prepared by Digerati and subject to this clause be delivered to the Licensee via email or the Internet for downloading by the Licensee. The terms of this licence apply to all such updates.

### **TRADEWISE TECHNICAL SUPPORT**

5.1 Digerati undertakes to provide telephone technical support for the Software to the Licensee through the Tradewise Assist help desk. Such technical support will only be provided for the latest version of the Software. This service is provided free of charge to the Licensee.

### **WARRANTY**

6.1 The Licensee acknowledges that the Software cannot be guaranteed or error free and further acknowledges that the existence of any such error or other defect shall not constitute a breach of this Licence and shall not give rise to any claim against or liability on the part of Digerati. This provision applies subject to any statutory provisions or requirements to the contrary.

6.2 In the event any statute implies terms into this Licence which cannot be lawfully excluded, such terms will apply to this Licence, save that the liability of Digerati for breach of any such implied term will be limited, at the option of Digerati, to either of the following: (a) the replacement of

the Software to which the breach relates or the supply of equivalent software; (b) the repair of such Software.

6.3 Digerati will not be liable for any indirect or consequential losses or damages suffered by Licensee arising out of a breach of this Licence or arising out of the supply of defective Software.

6.4 Digerati does not warrant the accuracy or completeness of any data or information which is supplied to it by third parties e.g. New Zealand Customs, MAF or any other organisation and which is included in the Software or update thereto. Digerati will not be liable for any damage whatsoever caused by any incomplete or incorrect data or information supplied to it by such third parties

### **COPYRIGHT/INDEMNITY**

7.1 The Software is protected by copyright laws and international treaty provisions. The Licensee acknowledges that all title and copyright in and to the Software (including, but not limited to images, photographs, animations, video, audio, text incorporated into the Software), are owned by Digerati. The Licensee shall not during or any time after the expiry or termination of this Licence permit any act which infringes the copyright and, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Licensee specifically acknowledges that he or she may not copy the program except as otherwise expressly authorised by this Licence.

7.2 The documentation referred to in clause 2 may not be copied, modified or used in any way not expressly authorised by this agreement. Additional copies of the documentation may be acquired from Digerati upon request.

7.3 The Licensee hereby indemnifies Digerati fully against all liabilities, costs and expenses, which Digerati may incur as a result of the Licensee's breach of the copyright provisions of this Licence or of any other provision of this Licence.

### **UPGRADES TO THE SOFTWARE**

8 The terms and conditions of this Licence shall apply equally to any upgrades to the Software provided to the Licensee by Digerati.

### **TERMINATION OF LICENCE**

9 Without prejudice to any other rights, Digerati may terminate this Licence if the Licensee fails to comply with the terms and conditions contained herein. In such event, the Licensee must, at the election of Digerati, return to Digerati or destroy all copies of the Software.

### **ASSIGNMENT**

10 The benefit of this Licence shall not be dealt with in any way by the Licensee (whether by assignment, sub-licensing or otherwise) without Digerati's written consent.

### **WAIVER**

11 Failure or delay by Digerati to enforce at any time any of the provisions of this Licence shall not be construed or deemed to be a waiver of that party's rights under this Licence.

### **GOVERNING LAW**

12 This Licence is governed by Victorian law.

### **CONSUMER GUARANTEES ACT 1993 (NZ)**

13 Where the Licensee acquires the Software for business purposes then the provisions of the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 (NZ) do not apply to this Licence.
